

Bank Supervision Learning Operational Risk Chair

Position Summary:

This position will fill the role as the Operational Risk Content Management Group (ORCMG) Chair and provide the needed strategic leadership and content expertise. The ORCMG works together as a team to provide bank examiner learning opportunities that provide staff opportunities to acquire the skill to assess operations risk within supervised institutions.

Job Duties and Responsibilities:

- Lead the ORCMG to develop, deliver and maintain operational risk content for assistant examiners.
- Lead the ORCMG to develop, deliver and maintain operational risk content for examiners.
- Ensure strategic connections of operational risk considerations across all risks and business operations.
- Evaluate current and identify new instructors for System operational risk courses. Provide recognition.
- Annually review vendor performance and recommend contract renewal or rebid.
- Acquire and direct resources with appropriate skill and competency to best utilize scarce resources.
- Actively serve as SuperVision Learning Advisory Group member to set direction of all examiner content.
- Lead and support ad hoc project work for the Examiner Commissioning Program (ECP) Modernization.
- Gather input from constituency groups to gain buy in and ensure the business needs are met.
- Follow emerging issues in operational risk, develop Rapid Response sessions and communicate with Staff Development Subcommittee (SDS), etc.

Job Qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree with major in Business Administration, Finance or Accounting.
- Bank Examiner Commissioning is strongly preferred.
- For candidates lacking an examiner commission, at least 10 years of successful banking experience with operational risk practices will be considered.
- Other relevant industry certifications such as the Certified Information Systems Auditor (CISA) and/or experience with Bank Secrecy Act (BSA), Anti-Money Laundering (AML), Internal/External Audit, Information Technology and Insurance are also strongly preferred.
